AUGUST 22, 2018

The Church Council of the Clarion First United Methodist Church met on Wednesday, August 22, 2018 with thirteen members and one guest present: Carolyn Bowman, Dennis Bowman, Jerry Boyington, Tana Boyington, Pastor Mike Gudka, Kelly Kirstein, Kent Kirstein, Jodi Kraft, Kim Marker, Daniel Murray, Kari Jo Murray, Carol Townend, Kathy Watts and Bud Young. Andy Young was the guest.

Chairperson, Carol called the meeting to order. Kent made a motion to adopt the agenda. Second by Bud. Voted on and carried. Denny made a motion to approve the minutes of the previous meeting (March 21, 2018). Second by Kent. Voted on and carried. Kent presented the Treasurer's Report. We are doing good and much better than last year. The ACH deposits seem to be helping.

Kim offered devotions. Members discussed the research presented by Pastor Mike and the videos and the book regarding the Special Conference coming in February 2019 in St. Louis. Kim presented a report on Annual Conference and her experience there. Andy Young presented a Word of Witness on his thoughts and feelings about the Special Conference decisions that might be made. There will be a live simulcast by the Wesley Global Gathering titled "Unashamed" at our church on Saturday, November 3 from 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.

Bud made a motion to allow "Proteus" to use our church. Second by Tana. Voted on and carried. Proteus provides basic health care for migrant workers. Carolyn made a motion to accept the draft as follows: While on Church property, all outside groups that use the Church's facility must respect and remain in alignment with the Church's beliefs found in the Book of Discipline; must follow the established Safe Sanctuary Policy; and must have proof of liability insurance. Exceptions to having liability insurance may be granted in specific situations (e.g. birthday parties, graduation parties, one-time education events, etc.). Second by Kim. Voted on and carried.

Rally Sunday will be September 9. All are encouraged to invite other to come. Services for the unchurched are being planned with Missionary training on Sunday, October 7, at 6:00 p.m. A practice run will be at Pizza Ranch on Sunday, October 14 at 5:00 p.m. with the first gathering on Sunday, November 11, at 5:00 p.m. at Pizza Ranch. They plan to meet monthly. Pastor Mike reported there will be slight changes to the beginning of the traditional service. Some upcoming Outreach events are Sunday, November 4 from 7:00 – 9:00 p.m. "Fight Night: A Fun Date Night" and March 28 the Christian Comedian Brad Stine will be presenting at both services and have a comedy show in the evening.

Charge Conference will be October 7 at the Eagle Grove Methodist Church.

Tana reported for the <u>Education</u> team. Rally Sunday will be September 9. The two services will start that day. Pastor Mike will be teaching Confirmation. Third graders will be presented with Bibles. The Christmas program will be December 9. Chrysalis will be here April 5 – 7. May 5 will be High School Senior and Teacher recognition with the Youth in charge of the Contemporary Service. The last day of Sunday school is May 12. Lesa Fishburn is starting a fellowship class for young moms. A written report from the <u>Memorial</u> team was presented. <u>Staff Parish</u> – Jerry reported that they haven't met. Pastor Mike reported for the <u>Worship</u> team that Karen and Lloyd Hill will be visiting shut-ins. <u>CHICKS</u> – Kelly reported that they will be meeting the first Wednesday in September. She is planning a Bible Study with girls and women. She is doing a teen ministry using Instagram. <u>MOE</u> – Daniel and Kari Jo reported they met last Sunday. There are Bibles in English and Spanish to give out. They have sent funds to Malawi to finish the Church. They are planning "Fight Night" and Brad Stine as mentioned earlier. A BBQ is planned at Lantern Apartments on September 20th. Plans are to go to "Beacon of Hope" on March 30th. <u>Board of Trustees</u> – Pastor Mike reported they are working on a leak in the basement. They have worked on the front church steps. The west sidewalk and front step to the education wing. The elevator will be serviced. <u>UMW</u> – Carolyn reported that "Sister's Day" was cancelled due to lack of interest. They will be working on the Chicken and Biscuit Dinner and Christmas Dinner. <u>Youth Group</u> – They will be meeting on the 2nd and 4th Wednesday's with a kick off planned on September 12.
